FURTHER DETAILS FOR THE BELCO ARTS INCLUSION AWARD

Eligibility:

Applicants must:

- identify as living with physical, sensory, d/Deaf or intellectual or as having experienced mental illness;
- be exploring their visual arts practice;
- provide a project description of what they would like to do; and
- be a resident within the Canberra region.

About the Award: The successful applicant will receive:

- \$2000 (funds to contribute towards the creation of new work); and
- an opportunity to explore their ideas, generate new work with a public outcome of their determination. This could be an exhibition, living studio residency or other public activation.

Applications

Applicants must:

- Outline their proposed project, detailing what they hope to produce and their public outcome in the “Project Details” section of the form.
- Provide a description of how the proposed activity will impact both their visual arts practice and audiences it aims to connect with.
- Provide a referee. NB: Your referee should be a person in good standing and will be asked to attest to the applicant’s *Bona Fides*.
